Dear TNF Members, Friends and Patrons,

The onset of the Covid-19 pandemic in 2020 and 2021 translated to a daunting challenge for my role as the TNF President. Our normal channels of social services in Tamil Nadu had to be carried out with a great degree of ingenuity and flexibility. With the able assistance of the TNF staff on the ground in India and our committed members in the U.S. we took recourse to a multitude of virtual engagements to simulate gatherings, meetings and fundraising events. It was quite heartening to see the continued generosity of many of the ardent supporters of TNF who opened their hearts and wallets to help the needy and the underserved.

During this year, TNF successfully conducted two major virtual fundraising events. For their part, TNF Chennai came up with the unique idea of Special Coaching Classes to the students in the ABC Schools, as well as for those appearing for the NEET exams, a challenging requirement for MBBS & BDS programs in the medical and dental colleges.

In May 2021, TNF joined hands with a multitude of organizations such as ATEA, Indiaspora, Fetna, ATMA, IIT Madras Foundation, IIT MANA, CTA and many others to raise nearly **One million dollars** to fight the Covid-19 resurgence in Tamil Nadu through the HelpTNBreathe Campaign. This is the first time that so many Tamil organizations have come together for one cause.

During the fiscal year 2020-2021:

The ABC Education Initiative has grown with many Chapters and individuals adopting districts and schools. To date, we have 125 partner schools in 15 districts and more than 90,000 beneficiaries. As you well know, the ABC initiative opens doors for many slow learners and underserved children all over Tamil Nadu. TNF Chennai conducted Special Coaching Classes in 12 districts that have benefitted 1282 students. In 2021, 1658 students attended the ABC classes and 1723 students received soft skills training, for a total of 4663 students benefiting from these programs. Coaching for the NEET exams were held for students in Thiruvarur and Nagapattinam districts.

Mann Vasanai: The largest initiative of TNF targets to raise funds (to the tune of \$ 9 million+, \$ 250,000 per district) to sustain the TNF projects in each of the 38 districts and the Union Territory of Puducherry. Nagapattinam, Namakkal, and Sivagangai have raised more than 60% of Phase I goal of 50 lakhs per district. With your help, we can fund all of them in the very near future.



Operational Efforts:

- The current Bylaws governing TNF activities were drafted by the Board of Directors at its inception. In 2021 the TNF Board appointed a Bylaw Committee to review and propose relevant revisions, and the committee's amendments were approved by the General Body. The amended bylaws give provision for two of the general directors to be Directors of Youth and Communication, and Technology management. Henceforth, the mode of communications to the general body will be only by electronic mail except for the few members without email.
- TNF Policy and Procedure Manual was created to give clarity to the roles of the various offices and their responsibilities.

Fundraising Efforts:

- TNF USA conducted Online Live Music Programs in August 2020 and January 2021 and raised close to \$175,000.00 for the ABC Initiative and the Mann Vaasanai Projects.
- In fiscal year 2020-2021 TNF received a total amount of **\$666,524** for the various board and individual projects a significant accomplishment considering the challenge we faced during the pandemic.
- TNF supporters from the US helped to raise more than **\$21,000** for the Covid-19 India Relief fund. This money was donated for RT PCR machines, PPEs, Oxygen concentrators in the most affected area hospitals in Tamil Nadu.
- TNF Chapters raised about **\$36,981** for the Covid-19 USA Relief fund to be given to Food Banks in various cities in the U.S.
- TNF Chicago Chapter raised **\$37,485** for the purchase of an RT-PCR Machine, a rapid screening assay, for Stanley Medical College and Hospital in Chennai.

TNF Service and Education Initiative: Since its inception the TNF Summer Internship program has enriched the lives of 134 U.S. born Tamil Youth from all across the country. Per the program's design and intent, these students spent time in various cities in Tamil Nadu, connecting to their roots and more importantly learning about the challenges faced by the local students in learning.

The rich experience has motivated some of these youth to start their own projects to help the children of Tamil Nadu. To-date, we have seven projects created by these youth.

The TAYMAI Grants is an extension of the project initiative and is managed by the Young Professional Committee. The YPC is assuming a key role in developing youth initiatives in many cities in the U.S.



In 2021, TNF Chapters continued to face challenges in raising funds. A few chapters conducted virtual walkathons. Only in April 2021 a few of the chapters begun to have programs. During the pandemic, virtual sessions were conducted with individual chapters by the President and VP Chapters to keep in touch and to encourage the chapter members.

TNF has maintained communications with its members and supporters with the publication of the monthly enewsletter Eegai, updates on Facebook about TNF and the Chapters, YouTube Posts of our activities, and Instagram postings.

In closing, it has been an immensely rewarding experience, making us realize that even in adversity TNF does receive a world of support from the Board Members in U.S., members of the chapters around the country, the staff at TNF Chennai, the Project Coordinators and teachers (who chose to work with the students even during the pandemic), the Chairman Thiru. Rajarethinam, the CEO Thiru. Ka.Ilango, and the Trustees of the TNF Chennai Center.

It has been a great honor, albeit a humbling experience, to be the first woman President in the history of Tamil Nadu Foundation and to serve in this difficult environment. I am very grateful for the support provided throughout my tenure by the TNF USA Board, the Chairman of TNF Chennai Trustees Thiru. S. Rajarethinamand the CEO of TNF Chennai Chapter Thiru. Ka. Ilango.

I am proud to be a part of this organization, and thankful for the opportunity given to me to be the President of this great organization that makes it its mission to serve the underserved in Tamil Nadu through Education, Women's Empowerment, Health & Hygiene, and Rural Development.

I will remain an integral part of the TNF and provide my dedicated support.

My best wishes to the new team of Board of Directors.

MESSAGE FROM CHAIRMAN, TNF CHENNAI

Vanakkam,

The year 2020 - 2021 was full of challenges and uncertainties. Consequent on the closure of Educational Institutions on account of Corona virus Pandemic, students had to go for to Online Coaching. However, access to online coaching to rural Government School Students posed logistical problems. Under these circumstances, TNF had organised Special Coaching classes in 12 districts utilizing the services of 60 ABC Teachers strictly following the standard operating procedures announced by Government for containment of the spread of COVID-19. Under this programme, 1282 rural students were benefitted.

Our decision to implement ABC Project in 19 districts in 78 schools increasing the number from the current 15 project districts covering 62 schools, could not be achieved due to lockdown.

When the schools were opened in January 2021, TNF, with the help of our dedicated field level staff conducted coaching classes for 1658 students besides imparting. Soft Skill training to 1723 students upto March 2021.

During this period 200 students have received scholarship worth Rs. 4.60 million.

Another milestone in our activities in the year 2020 is the supply of medical equipments costing Rs. 5.8 million to Government Medical Institutions. These equipments have been put to use not only for diagnostic purposes but also for teaching and Research purposes.

TNF, with the available funds has organised online coaching which has received overwhelming response from the students.

COVID-19 INDIA RELIEF AND REHABILITATION EFFORTS

In Early 2020 Covid -19 spread rapidly throughout the world and Tamil Nadu was not spared. The situation was very difficult and the state faced a shut down. TNF USA sprang to action immediately and raised funds to help the underserved in Tamil Nadu.

TNF Chicago Chapter raised \$37,485 to provide an RT -PCR machine for Stanley medical college. Generous donations poured in and TNF was able to provide RT-PCR machine to Madurai Rajaji Medical college, PPE kits to Government medical hospital in Thiruvarur and Chengalpet. Rice bags and essential kits were distributed. TNF South Florida chapter raised funds to provide several Oxygen concentrators and oxygen cylinders to Kilpauk medical hospital in Chennai. In total TNF raised about \$58,000 to provide the instruments and PPE kits to the most needy in Tamil Nadu.

In May 2021, 360 Oxygen concentrator, PPE kids etc. were sents to Tamil Nadu at the value more than \$500,000. As always during urgent and difficult times, TNF lends helping hand to the needy in Tamil Nadu.

Stanley gets fund for RT-PCR machine: After the dean of Government Stanley Medical College Hospital requested Tamil Nadu Foundation to help get RT-PCR machine to facilitate Covid-19 screening, TNF has come forward to make the donation. The machine costs of !32.62 lakh. Dr. Dilli Rani, Professor of microbiology, received a cheque for the amount. The machine will be used by the premier institute not only for the diagnosis of Covid-19 but also for education and research activities. Tamil Nadu Foundation is a 45year-old charitable trust supported by more than 1,000 NRI members. Its members from the US are curently helping students studying in government schools in rural Ramil Nadu.



- Over 65% of donations were from the \$1000 - \$4999, \$10,000-\$24,999, and > 25000 ranges.







2020 - 2021 Contributions & Grants




2020-2021 Contributions & Grants Month

TNF ABC INITIATIVE

TNF's ABC initiative aims to enrich and empower underprivileged students by providing resources, programs, and tools currently not provided by the school to continue their education without dropping out. This year, we further expanded the initiative to include students from 6th to 12th grade, ranging from academically challenged to highly ambitious students.

TNF has appointed Project Coordinators and teachers to closely collaborate with the school teachers to best address students' needs. As of March 2021, since its inception, 90,000 students in 19 districts have benefitted from the ABC initiative.

The three components of the initiative are:

- Achieving academic proficiency (The focus is on "academically challenged" students from 6th to 10th grades. One-third of the students in government schools are far below their grade level in essential reading and writing skills. Due to public exam expectations and pressure in high schools, they are likely to become school dropouts. The ABC Class helps them to improve and become grade proficient.)
- Boosting their morale (For all students: Training, Workshops, and Summer Camps to address 'soft skills' like self-confidence, communication skills, time management, goal setting, teamwork, etc.).
- Championing for higher aspirations (10th to 12th grades: Preparing for public exams, orientation to college
 education, career guidance, scholarships, campus visits, career guidance, internships, job placement,
 becoming role models)

Special Coaching Classes: Due to the pandemic, the 2020-2021 school year was a challenge for conducting regular ABC classes. The ABC Teachers did their best by providing special coaching sessions in available spaces to help students who were willing to attend. Under this program 1282 students have benefitted.

NEET coaching classes - As a pilot project, virtual online coaching was given to 90+ underprivileged students in Nagapattinam and Thiruvarur districts, preparing for the NEET entrance exams to gain admission to medical and dental schools.







Membership Native District in Tamil Nadu



GAJA CYCLONE RELIEF AND REHABILITATION WORK PROJECT 2020 - 2021

Cyclone Gaja devastated many lives in the coastal districts of Tamil Nadu in November 2018. Thiruvarur, Nagapattinam, Thanjavur, and Pudukottai districts were the most affected areas.

Responding with a sense of utmost emergency, TNF immediately organized a fundraising campaign. With the support of its Chapters, partner organizations, and numerous individuals, TNF was able to extend relief to the people in the affected areas period.

- a. Construction of 9 makeshift houses to the beneficiaries in Muthanpallam village of Pudukottai District which was completely damaged during Gaia cyclone with an estimated total value of Rs.11,25,000/- with the funding support from TNF Dallas Chapter and a sum of **Rs. 4,72,500**/-was settled during this year.
- b. Repair and Renovation of classrooms damaged by Gaia cyclone was done in Government High school, Gramamedhumedu, Nagapattinam for **Rs. 3,96,500/-**

Anbalayam - Home for differently abled Children, Sirkali.

An abandoned child, with special needs, in a bus depot or a public place can be a heart-wrenching sight. *Anbalayam* was started (in Sirkali) by a philanthropist to care for such children. Unfortunately, it was a major struggle for the founder due to lack of adequate resources, and the children had to be housed in dilapidated buildings, with leaky roofs and poor sanitary provisions. Thanks to the efforts of the TNF, Anbalayam has been transformed into a 3000 square foot building, equipped with furnished classrooms, separate toilet & bathroom facilities for boys and girls. More importantly, a corpus fund, to the tune of one crore rupees, has been established to meet the operating expenses of the facility in a sustainable manner.





Digital Classrooms

The 'Digital Divide' that the children in the Government Schools face is huge and wide - a stark reality between the haves and have-nots!

We have started two projects to address this issue - The "Smart Classroom Pilot Project," *Vadasithur Govt. Hr Sec School, Coimbatore*, and the "Self-Guided Digital Classroom", *Govt. Hr. Sec School, Arumbakkam.*

HIGHLIGHTS OF THE TNF TAMIL NADU CHAPTER ACTIVITIES (MAY 2020 - MAY 2021)

I. ABC Education Project in Government Schools

Due to the COVID-19 pandemic government schools were closed for most of the academic year. Hence, TNF initiated the ABC "Special Coaching Classes" off campus in ABC Project areas. When schools were in session for a brief period, Soft Skill Training for high school students and the ABC regular classes for academically challenged students were conducted in the schools.

Summary of Beneficiaries:

ABC Special Coaching Class - 1282
ABC Regular Class - 1658
Soft Skill Training (28 schools in 12 districts) - 1723
Total No. of beneficiaries - 4663

II. Educational Scholarship

A sum of Rs. 45,85,165/- was sanctioned to enrich 201 underprivileged students with higher education.

III. Libraries are Temple Project

a. Somalay Memorial Branch Library, Nerkuppai

Spoken English classes and JEE Coaching classes were initiated as a pilot through online coaching by volunteers in USA. About 25 rural students benefited from this pilot initiative.

b. Anvarthikanpet Branch Library, Ranipet

The students from ABC Special Coaching classes were given computer training. A volunteer from the local area provided the training to 220 students.

IV. COVID-19 - Research and Educational Project

RT-PCR Machines were donated to Stanley Government Medical College, Chennai and to the Madurai Medical College. More than 400,000 samples were tested with these units in the first few months of use and the instruments were also useful for research studies by post graduate students. TNF also supplied 10 Oxygen Concentrators and 50 Oxygen Cylinders to Kilpauk Medical College, Chennai. Funds donated in the first phase of Covid relief include:

Stanley Medical College and Hospital - Rs. 32,62,000/Kilpauk Medical College and Hospital - Rs. 8,24,000/Thiruvarur Medical College and Hospital - Rs. 1,07,500/Madurai Medical College - Rs. 13,50,000/Chengalpattu Medical College - Rs. 1,13,800/-

V. Gaja Cyclone Relief and Rehabilitation work Project

- a. Construction of 9 make-shift houses to Cyclone Gaja affected families in Muthanpallam at Pudukottai District was completed at a cost of Rs.11,25,000/- with funding support from TNF Dallas Chapter.
- b. Repair and Renovation of classrooms at Government High School, Gramamedhumedu, Nagapattinam were completed at a cost of Rs. 3,96,500/-

VI. NEET Coaching Classes

The NEET Online Tamil Medium (35 students) and English Medium (48 students) coaching classes for aspiring Medical students were conducted in Kasthurba Gandhi Kanya Gurukulam, Vedaranyam. About 35 students from Govt. and Govt. Aided schools took advantage of this new initiative. Since the Govt. of Tamil Nadu has allotted 7.5% of the medical college admissions to students from Govt. school students this coaching will be very useful for the students in the rural area.

VII. Other Activities

a. Government Higher Secondary School for the Visually Impaired, Poonamallee, Thiruvallur District

Construction of the security cabin, new roofs for classrooms and repair of the main gate and the entrance were completed with the funding support from TNF Dallas Chapter at a cost of Rs.19,46,817/-.

b. Tailoring Education

TNF has signed MOU with Apparel Training and Design Centre, a Government of India undertaking, to run an advanced tailoring education project on a rent free basis at the Chennai centre building with effect from 15th July, 2020, initially for the period of 11 months.

c. TREC-STEP

The TREC-STEP which had occupied the 1st and 2nd floor of the TNF Center in Chennai has vacated the 1st floor by end of November 2020. They continue to function from the 2nd floor of the TNF Center.

d. MOU between TNF & Vaithilingam Parasakthi Elamathi Trust

TNF has signed the MOU with VaithilingamParasakthi Elamathi Trust to operate the Centre for Medical Genetics with effect from 31st July 2020 initially for a period of 11 months. The equipment and other assets recovered from GenVams Trust (purchased with TNF Funds) were handed over to the Managing Trustee of Vaithilingam Parasakthi Elamathi Trust by TNF.

e. ABC Project implementation Manual

ABC Project implementation Manual has been prepared to ensure consistency in implementation of this education project in government schools across all the districts.

VIII. Foreign Contribution Regulation Act (FCRA)

- a. New FCRA main account and operational account has been opened as per the FCRA policies and started operating.
- b. The renewal (FC-3C) of FCRA submitted to Ministry of Home Affairs on 8th May 2021. Currently the FCRA is available up to November 2021.
- c. The renewal of 80G and 12AA submitted to Income Tax department on 7th May 2021.


